and families.

**Birth certificates are often needed to receive medical assistance, housing and other public benefits, to obtain a Pennsylvania driver's or non-driver's license, for access to many public buildings, for general identification and many other purposes.**

**Homeless individuals who attend this free clinic will meet with an advocate who will request birth certificates for them and their minor children free of charge.**

**Birth certificates requested at this clinic may not be back before Labor Day, September 5, 2016.**

**HAP does not help individuals obtain PENNDOT identification.**
